- 3. Chairperson Report Welch
  - a. Discussion of Committee Project Goals and Milestones
    - i. Fresh Start Donation Campaign (Friend)
      - 2,987 items collected from 31 businesses and 7 residence buildings.
      - 37,344 feminine hygiene products donated from Kindfully and a \$2,218 check presented from Solita Tacos & Margarita's.
    - ii. Scooters and Pedestrian Safety (Krieger)
      - ADA/parking compliance field visit with Veoride is being scheduled.
    - iii. Safety Escort Promotion (Panuco)
      - Businesses have been placing in requests for which poster works best for them.
      - Safety Ambassadors will distribute posters and cards to businesses.
- 4. Public Safety Partners Report
  - a. Long Beach Police Department
    - Surveillance video was collected from the theft of generators at the Taste of Downtown event and the investigation is in process.
    - Burglary detectives are seeking better video surveillance of the recent window smashes and theft of credit card readers.
    - The business license for JP23 has been denied.
    - Sergeant Ernest will look into an old program where businesses would submit their own camera info for surveillance viewing.

- 5. Staff Report Broc Coward
  - a. Lincoln Park Activation
    - There will be a group focusing on direct oversight and community input, while another group works on fundraising.
    - Currently in phase 0, the park is being tested for ground activities, marketing, procedures, and stakeholder feedback.
    - Activities include dog obedience classes, Zumba/Bollywood dance classes, marionette puppet show, after work picnic, and gardening.
    - LB Walls & Art Renzei's Stand Up Art Festival and KCRW's Summer Nights will both take place at Lincoln Park.
  - b. Public Safety Perception Survey
    - The general cleanliness rating of Downtown has decreased over the past 4 years and there was an over 10% drop for people perceiving Downtown as a good place to live, work, and visit.
    - The number of people aware of services DLBA provides, and what the City is doing to assist individuals experiencing homelessness has increased.
    - Safety in/around parking lots has a weighted score for high priority.
