- 3. CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT Pierzina
 - A. Bylaw Review/Amendments
 - i. Partial Term Flexibility (DLBA Bylaws Section 11.2)
 - The Committee reviewed the language that limits terms to 6
 years or three, two-year terms consecutively. Currently the
 Bylaws do not account for partial terms which the
 Committee is considering amending.
 - ii. Additional Neighborhood Seats (DLBA Bylaws Section 6.2)
 - Pierzina and Metoyer explained the need for additional representation from certain areas within the Downtown Parking & Business Improvement Area (DPBIA). The DLBA recognizing 5 different marketing areas, however, after review it is recommended that two of those areas be divided to better represent the different experiences in the respective neighborhoods.
 - It is recommended that the North Pine neighborhood be divided into North Pine & Willmore, and that the East Village neighborhood be divided into East Village and North East Village. Each new neighborhood will be given a voting seat on the Board of Directors.
 - This recommendation aligns with DLBA's Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Access (DEIA) Framework.

<u>ACTION:</u> Consideration for the creation of two new Downtown Parking & Business Improvement District (DPBIA) marketing areas within the existing DPBIA boundaries: North East Village and Willmore Historic District
