

WEST GATEWAY

Known as the financial and governmental center of DTLB, the West Gateway is home to the 104 Long Beach Civic Center, World Trade Center, the **Deukmejian Courthouse**, New Long Beach Library, and many of the city's office high-rises. DOWNTOWN

CORE

Situated around Pine Avenue and The Promenade, the Downtown Core is the bustling heart of DTLB and features a variety of restaurants, entertainment, and award-winning craft beer and cocktail establishments. Within the Downtown Core is North Pine, a neighborhood that is home to historic buildings, the Historic Pine Avenue sign, and multiple eateries. Don't forget to visit the nation's first park named after 10 Harvey Milk, an American politician and the first openly gay elected official in the history of California.

DAY ONE | ITINERARY



Begin your day of adventure with breakfast and a cup of coffee at one of the many famed coffee houses in Downtown. Explore the East Village Arts District and discover murals by local and world-renowned artists, unique shops and galleries, and architectural gems. Spend the rest of the morning at the Pacific Island Ethnic Art Museum and the Museum of Latin American Art, known as MOLAA.

Grab a bike and head to the Waterfront for lunch at one of the many restaurants located along Rainbow Harbor. Stop at the unique shops at Shoreline Village or find a great bargain at the Pike Outlets. At the Aquarium of the Pacific, come face-to-face with the ocean's ultimate predators in Shark Lagoon, hand-feed colorful lorikeet birds, and watch Magellanic penguins play.

Walk along Pine Avenue and spot the sea creatures in the crosswalk murals between 1st Street and 7th Street and gaze up at architectural history represented by the Farmers & Merchants Bank, Kress, and Walker buildings.

Choose from a variety of culinary choices along Pine Avenue and The Promenade. From the Pine Avenue to the East Village, Downtown has an active nightlife and plenty of craft beers and cocktails from which to choose. If you find yourself with a craving, check out the sweet treats along Pine Avenue.

HALF DAY | ITINERARY

Start your half-day adventure with a leisurely stroll along the streets of the East Village Arts District. Here you'll find eclectic boutique shops, architectural gems, and plenty of Long Beach's well-known street murals. East Village has several options to grab coffee, a hearty breakfast, or dinner and drinks.

Head to **The Loop** at Pine + Ocean, a massive art sculpture that lights up at night, before taking a short walk to Rainbow Harbor. The picturesque Waterfront has several photo spots from Shoreline Village to Lions Lighthouse. During the summer, take a break by enjoying the cool ocean breeze aboard Long

Beach Transit's AquaBus or AquaLink. These water taxis will take you to the Queen Mary, Shoreline Village, Aquarium of the Pacific, Hotel Maya and Alamitos Bay. After your adventure off-shore, spend the afternoon on foot or bike in historic Wilmore City, Long Beach's first neighborhood. The quiet tree lined streets of Wilmore City is where you'll find the ornate Late Victorian Bembridge House among Craftsman, Mission, and Spanish architectural styles.
