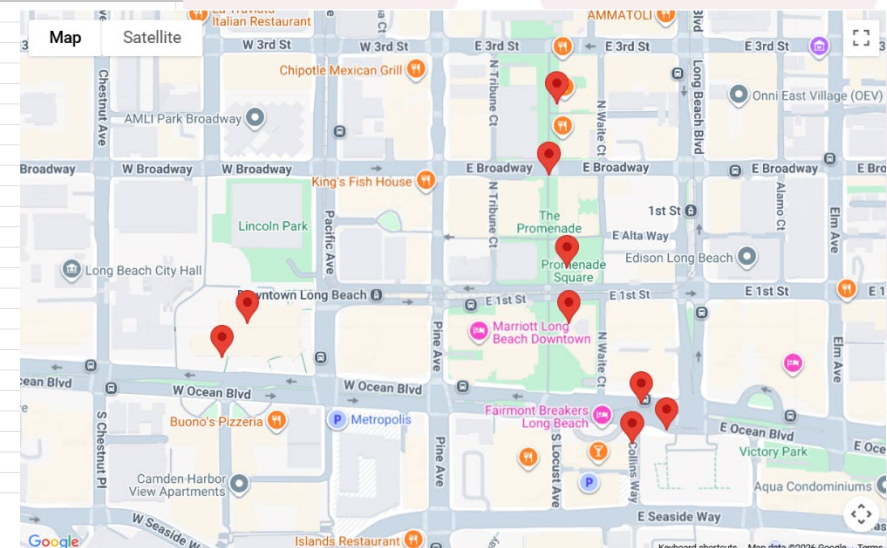
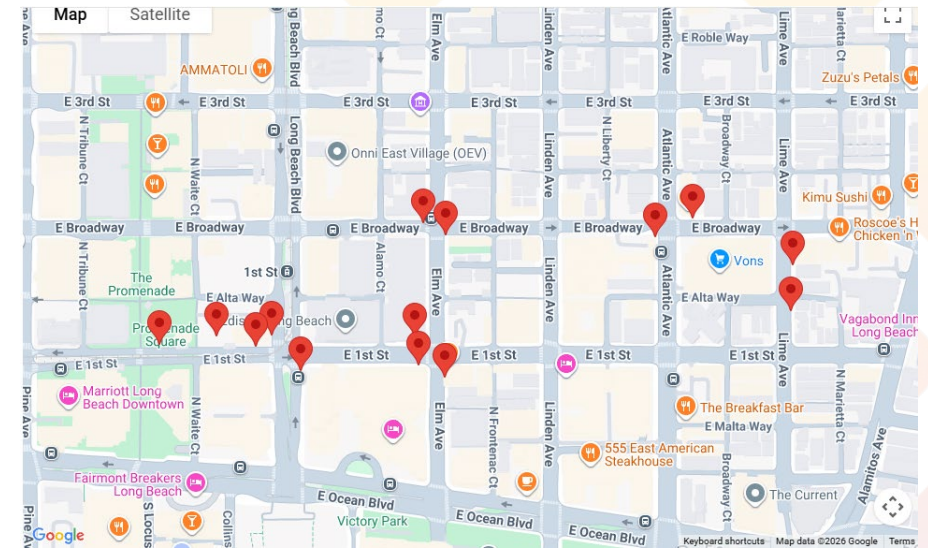

602 No Trespassing Program

WHAT: The posted signs notify the public that you authorize patrol officers to request trespassers to leave a private property and/or make an arrest when necessary if they refuse to leave.	RENEWAL: Program is valid for one year. Property owners or agents need to contact us or LBPD to renew on a yearly basis or to advise of disenrollment from the program.
WHERE: Post signs in a visible location on the property where they cannot be torn down. Examples of the sign are on the back of this card.	HOW: Scan the QR Code on the back of this card to inform DTLB Alliance staff to connect with you to discuss the LBPD program and process.
