- 4. STAFF REPORT Mader & Ancalade
 - A. Tabulate Slate Votes Mader & Stephens
 - Mader reviewed the results from the DPBIA. 25 votes were cast for the slate, with 23 in favor. This reflects a 92% approval.
 - Since the PBID is weighted, Mader and Stephens tabulated the results one by one to show the weighted approval.
 - 70 votes were cast for the PBID with 62 in favor. This indicates a 98% approval.
