- RFP Timeline for Clean and Safe Services
 - March 15, 2023 Announcement
 - March 28, 2023- Proposal released on DLBA's website
 - April 19, 2023 -Bidders Conference. Five vendors attended
 - May 3, 2023- Proposal due. Three proposals received.
 - May 23, 2023- Interview with three vendors.
 - June 14, 2023- Board recommendation
 - October 1, 2023 New Contract takes effect
- RFP Committee-
 - Isidro Panuco- Public Safety Committee Chair, Cheryl Roberts- Public Safety Committee Co-Chair, Sergeant Mark Mesun-LBPD, James Ahumada-Vice President and Juan Torres- Operations Manager.

Vendor A

- Pros: Cleaning experience. Ability to pivot to address the needs of funder.
- Cons: No experience in safety and homeless outreach.

Vendor B

- **Pros:** Experience in cleaning, safety and homeless outreach. Assistance in the purchasing and acquisition of assets. Software program that address the needs of DLBA's. Lowest of all three vendors. Highest salary per hour.
- Cons: Homeless Outreach not as experience.

Vendor C

- **Pros:** Extensive experience in homeless outreach. Experience in cleaning and safety. Software program address the needs of DLBA. Unrestricted monetary donation or equipment. Concierge and customer service.
- Cons: Most expensive of all three vendors.

6A. Clean & Safe Contract

ACTION: Authorize President & CEO to enter into negotiations and execute a contract with selected vendor for combined Clean & Safe services in the amount not to exceed \$2.8 million for FY23-24 commencing October 1, 2023, adjusting accordingly in subsequent years based on annual budgets through September 30, 2026, not to exceed a total contract value of \$8.2 million over a 3-year term.

Project Overview

- Project Address: 521 and 527 E. 4th St.
 - Holos also owns 530 E 4th St.
- Former Long Beach Housing Authority Building and adjacent parking lot
- Made possible by AB 2345, AB 2097 and the LB Downtown Plan (PD-30)





Project Overview

- Project Height: 14 stories, 168 feet
- Community Room Space: 1,606 sq ft
- Commercial Space: 1,200 sq ft
- Unit Count: 103 1-bedroom units
 - 76 units of Permanent Supportive Housing
 - 25 units of General Affordable Housing
 - 2 units set aside for on-site Property Management



Safety & Security

- 24/7 Property Management, managers will live on-site
- Tenants sign year-long lease & House Rules at lease-up
- Security cameras, secured entryways
- On-Site Supportive Services (MHALA)
 - 4-5 Case Managers for PSH units
 - 1 Resident Service Coordinator for GA units
- 2 On-Site Property Managers (LMG)
