 - A. **Board and Committee** Vacancies
 - i. Board Vacancies:
 - (a) DPIA East Village (1)
 - This seat was made vacant by the relocation of Jeremy Schott's business.
 - In a previous meeting Kripp mentioned that Suarez had a potential candidate who owns a floral shop in the area.
 - Suarez requested clarification to the boundaries of this district and will reach out to candidate to gauge interest.

- B. Review Bylaws + Election Procedures
 - Cadavona confirmed that all current committee and Board members should have the most recent Bylaws + Election Procedures.
 - Based on State of California Executive Order <u>N-29-20</u>, Cadavona and Kojian acknowledge the shift in organizational practices brought on by the pandemic (i.e.: Zoom Teleconferencing and freezing the Board and committees). They recommended that the committee consider these adjustments when reviewing potential Bylaw amendments, in compliance with State Law.
 - The Committee will revisit the potential amendments to these documents again in January.
